

## Melfort Evangelical Covenant Church Funding Application for Short-Term Missions Service

As a Church and Missions Committee we desire to know Jesus and make him known in our community and to the ends of the Earth. We are excited to see people of all ages passionately obeying the great commission.

### I. Purpose

This application is for monetary funds to assist individuals who attend MECC who desire to participate in a short-term missions experience. Money is set aside in the Missions Budget to come along side those who are desiring to serve God in this way.

### II. Criteria

In order to receive funds, the individual must attend MECC and participate in a short-term mission experience. Consideration will be given to the individuals commitment to missions as demonstrated through church involvement and exemplary Christian character.

### III. Process of Approval

The applicant will fill out this application and attach a prayer letter if they have one. They will submit the application to any of the Missions Committee members at least 60 days before their Missions service begins. Approval will be based on the criteria noted above as well as an evaluation of the Mission Agency. The amount of funds allocated per applicant will be based on the individuals need and the length of the missions experience. The Missions Committee may also contact the applicant for more information. Approval of applications will be decided by the Missions Committee and affirmed by the Elders of MECC. Following approval, the applicant will be contacted by the Missions Committee before their mission experience begins.

### IV. Sharing God's Work

The applicant may be asked to share with the church family about their experience prior to departure. This is for spiritual encouragement and enveloping prayer through their service. At the conclusion of the applicants service, it will be expected that they will prepare a short report for the Missions Committee or share on a Sunday morning about their short-term mission experience.
